**Spending Money and Valuables**

There may be an occasion where a trip out of camp will happen too. Cadets are not to bring large amounts of cash, preferably no more than £25-£30. If more money is required by cadets, the safest option is to use a debit card (where facilities allow).

The responsibility of securing valuables, lies with the owner. We will not accept any liability for any loss, damage or theft of any money or valuable items, such as jewellery, electronic items (i.e. laptops, phones, tablets, etc.)

**Prohibited Items**

The following are not to be brought to camp (any cadet found with any of the items below will have them confiscated and may be returned home): Replica or offensive weapons (lock knives, flick knives, machetes, firearms), pyrotechnic devices or laser pens.
