Most universities have informed the students of their decisions for 2025 applications. However, universities have until May to do this, so students should not be concerned if they are still waiting to hear, it means that the universities are still considering them. Students can only select their firm and insurance choice once they have received a decision from all the universities they applied to, the deadline for this is 4 June, however it is advised to do this **before you start study leave if possible.** Remember your insurance choice should require lower grades than your firm choice.
